

## DECLARATION

The company ArcelorMittal Frýdek-Místek a.s. declares that its products, cold rolled steel sheets and coils contain no dangerous chemical substances in such amount which could threaten human health or living environment.

**REF.: Statement related to the fulfillment of EP Regulation & European Council's Regulation # 1907/2006 (REACH) in relation to Metallurgical Products produced by ArcelorMittal Frýdek - Místek a. s.**

Products produced by ArcelorMittal Frýdek - Místek a. s. specified in the Production Program are in duly compliance with the definition of the term „Subject” under Art. 3, Par. 3, EP Regulation & European Council's Regulation # 1907/2006 (hereinafter referred to as the Regulation).

Definition: For the purposes of the Regulation, “Subject” shall be understood the Subject gaining – during the production - particular shape, surface or features specifying its function to a greater extent than its chemical composition.


**Under the Regulation, Metallurgical Products produced by ArcelorMittal Frýdek - Místek a. s. shall not be registered.**

ArcelorMittal Frýdek - Místek a. s. hereby states that its Products do not contain any hazardous matters / substances listed in the Candidate List issued by the European Chemical Agency - ECHA/PR/08/34.

We declare that all products, cold rolled steel sheets and coils produced by ArcelorMittal Frýdek-Místek a.s. contain no following dangerous substances: lead (Pb), mercury (Hg), cadmium (Cd), hexavalent chromium (Cr<sup>VI+</sup>), polybrominated biphenyls (PBB) and polybrominated diphenyl ethers (PBDE) in over-limit amounts and they are in full harmony with legal requirements:

- Directive 2000/53/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council of 18 September 2000 on end-of life vehicles, under art. 4, par. 2a) and Annex II hereof
- Directive 2002/95/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 January 2003 on the restriction of the use of certain hazardous substances in electrical and electronic equipment, under art. 4, par. 1 and Annex hereof.
