

Tubular Products targets to be one of the world leaders on its markets

So as to progress towards our objective to build a key player in the pipe and tube business, the GMB has taken the decision to integrate the operations of our worldwide Tube and Pipe manufacturing facilities into an entity, within ArcelorMittal, called Tubular Products.

The Tubular Products division operates 21 plants located in 12 countries worldwide, and targets to be one of the key leaders of the world wide Tubular Products market.

The Tubular Products division will be organized into three Market Entities covering the three key markets of Automotive, Energy and Mechanical. The headquarter is in Rotterdam.

This new organization will be under the leadership of **Jerome Granboulan**, CEO, reporting to **Malay Mukherjee**, Senior Executive Vice President ArcelorMittal, member of the GMB.

The main positions in the organization, reporting to the CEO are the following:

- **Bill Chisholm**, Chief Operating Officer. The leaders of the three Market Entities will report to Bill:
 - **Jim Baske**, Director Mechanical, will have responsibility for all global mechanical operations.
 - **Rick Legate**, Director Automotive, will be responsible for all automotive sites in Canada, France, Mexico and the U.S.A.
 - **Tomas Teluch**, Director Energy, now assumes responsibility for all the global Energy related businesses.
- **Sanjiv Goel**, Director Strategy and Projects, will oversee the continued formalization of the strategy work and completion of Greenfield projects.
- **Tapas Rajderkar**, Director Marketing and Sales, will build the complete Marketing and Sales approach for the new organization, to ensure we provide consistent and effective approaches to the market place.
- **Marcos Gonzalez**, CFO, Marcos will be responsible for all Finance and IT work for the entity.
- **Rob Parker**, Director Human Resources, Health and Safety. Rob will have global responsibilities for HR, Health and Safety across the 21 plant locations.
- **Dominique Lebigot**, Director Procurement, Dominique will be responsible for procurement.
